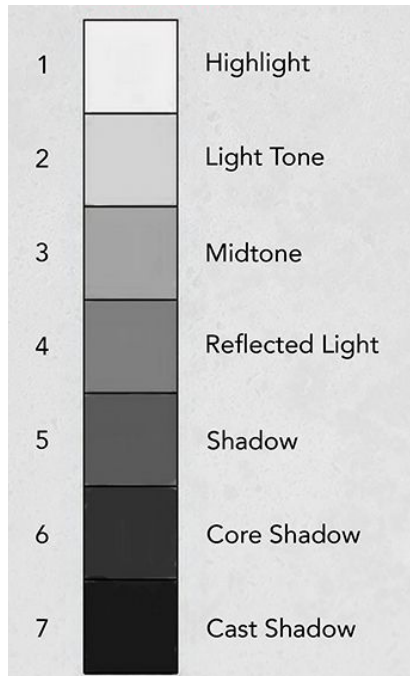


Bellwork Week 7 - USE FULL PAGE

Still Life/ Naturaleza muerta

□ A picture or arrangement of inanimate objects such as fruit, pottery, and flowers.

Why would an artist create a Still-Life?



Still Life

- In Dutch still lifes, objects were often visual symbols for ideas. A book might be a symbol for wisdom. A burning candle might be a symbol for life.

En los bodegones holandeses, los objetos eran a menudo símbolos visuales de ideas. Un libro puede ser un símbolo de sabiduría. Una vela encendida podría ser un símbolo para la vida.

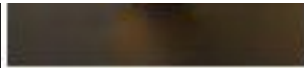
Still Life

- The artist has a chance to arrange objects in order to work out the composition of their artwork. In addition, they are a great way to practice and develop observational drawing techniques.

Use Hierarchy/ Usar jerarquía



larger than other
elements in a design

más grande que otros
elementos en un diseño

Use Overlapping/ Usar superposición

**Overlapping Helps to Show
Depth and Space!**

is the placement of objects over one another in order to create the illusion of depth.

es la colocación de objetos unos sobre otros para crear la ilusión de profundidad.

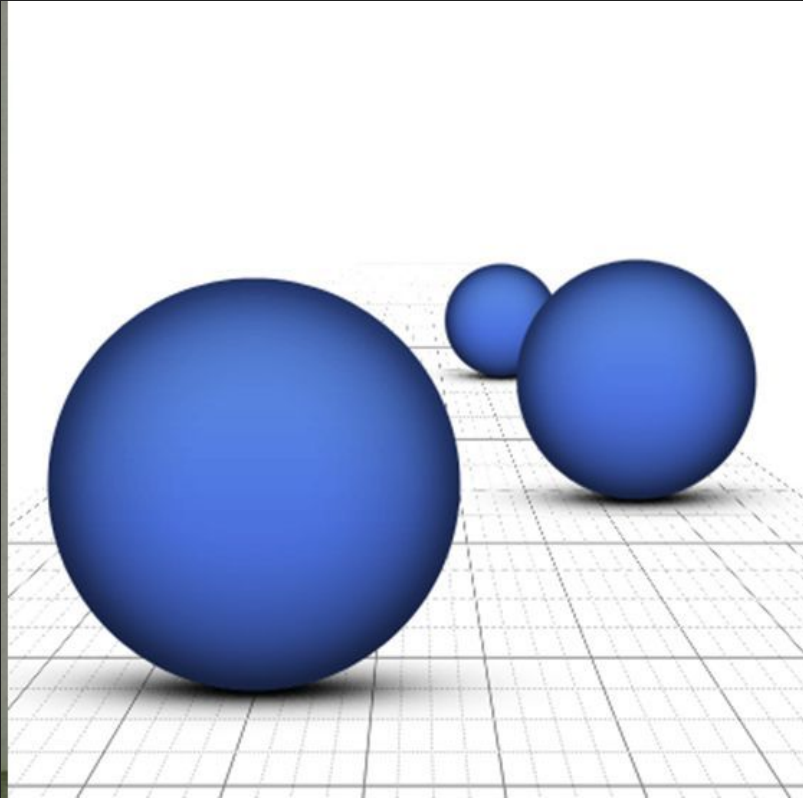
Use Proportion/ Usar proporción



refers to the relative size of parts of a whole (elements within an object).

se refiere al tamaño relativo de partes de un todo (elementos dentro de un objeto).

Use Placement/ Usar ubicación

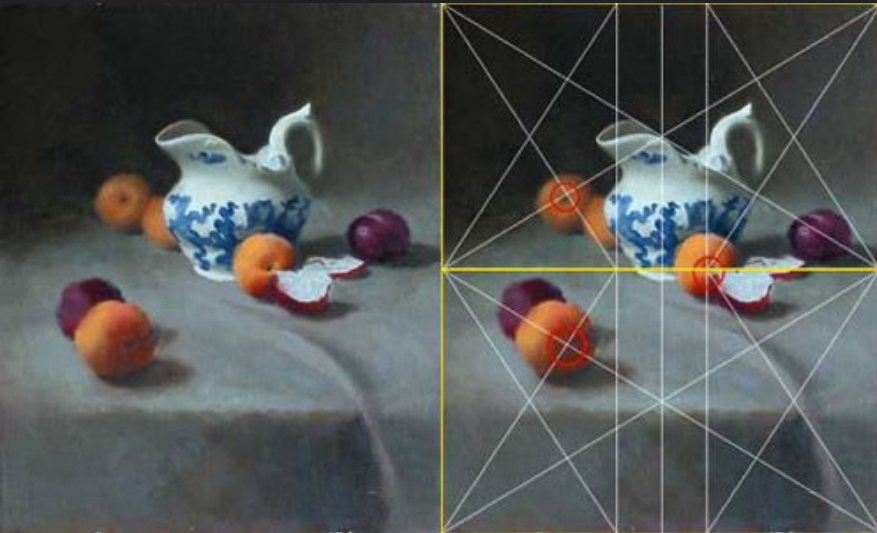


is placing objects that you want to appear closer to your eye lower on the surface of your drawing (and placing objects that you want to appear further away higher on the surface of your drawing).

es colocar objetos que desea que aparezcan más cerca de su ojo más abajo en la superficie de su dibujo (y colocar objetos que desea que aparezcan más lejos en la superficie de su dibujo).

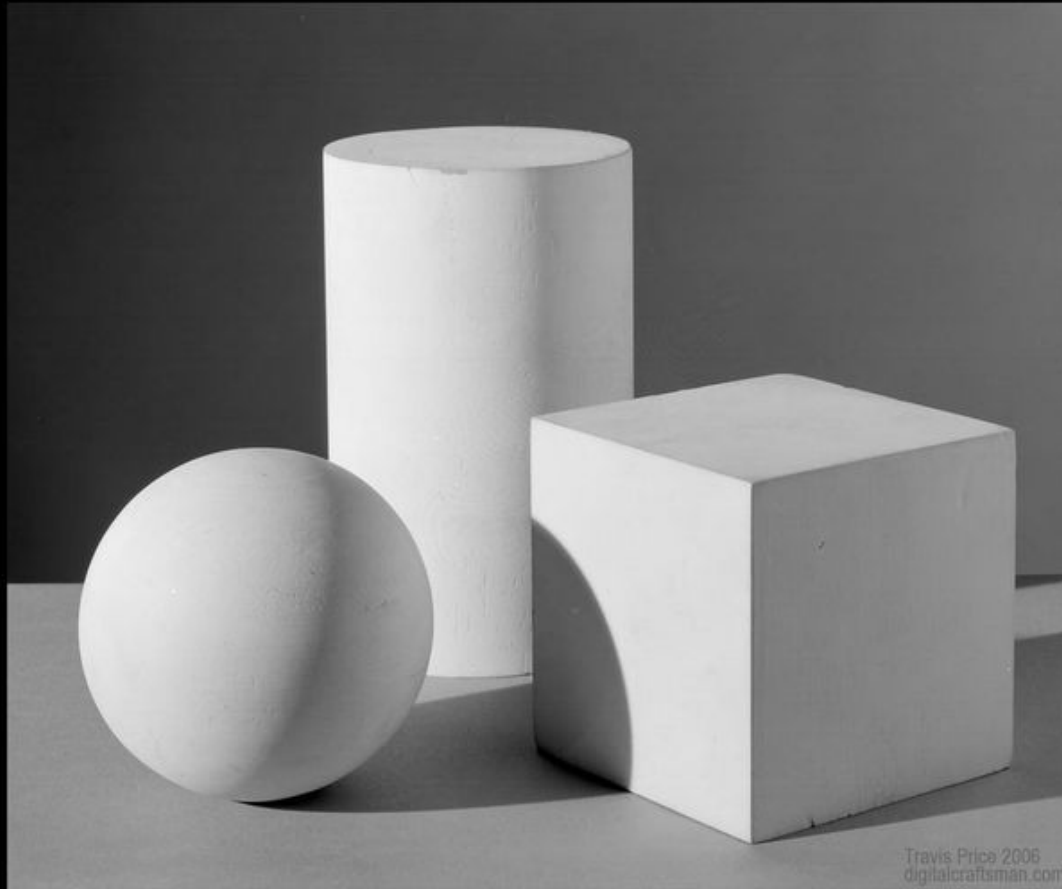
Use Diagonals/ Usar diagonales

is placing objects in a slanted arrangement.





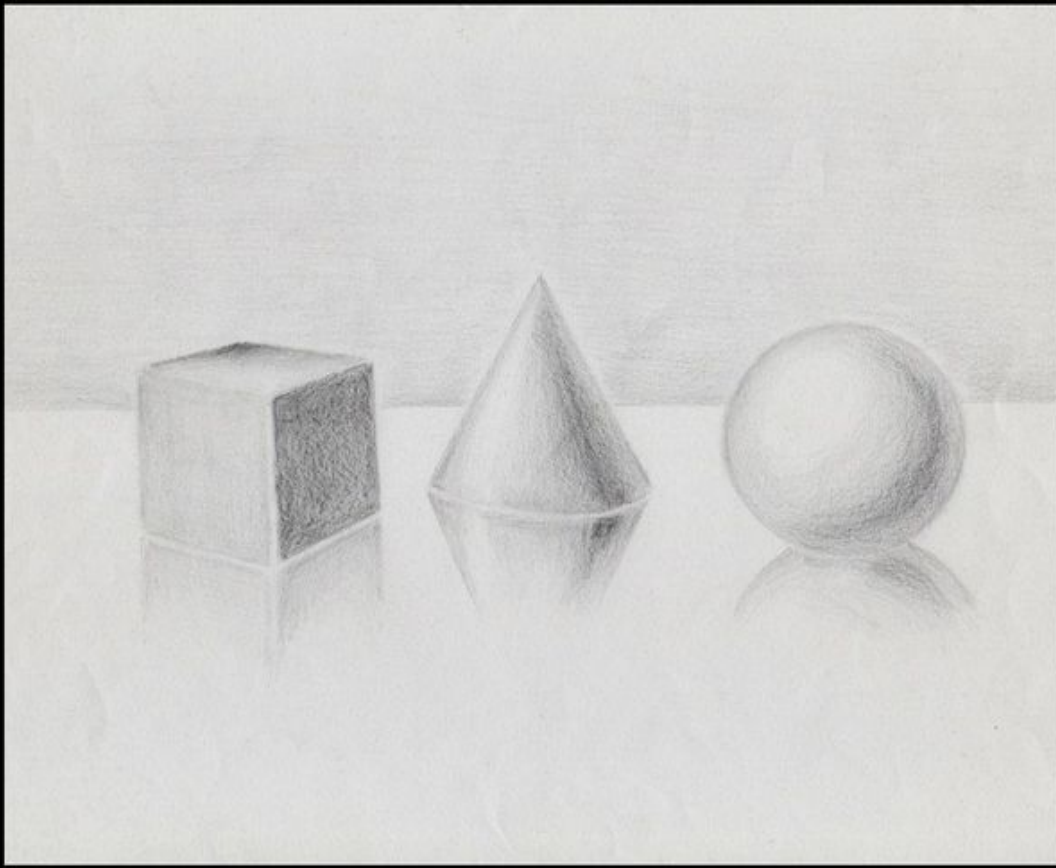
This composition is too simple and basic.



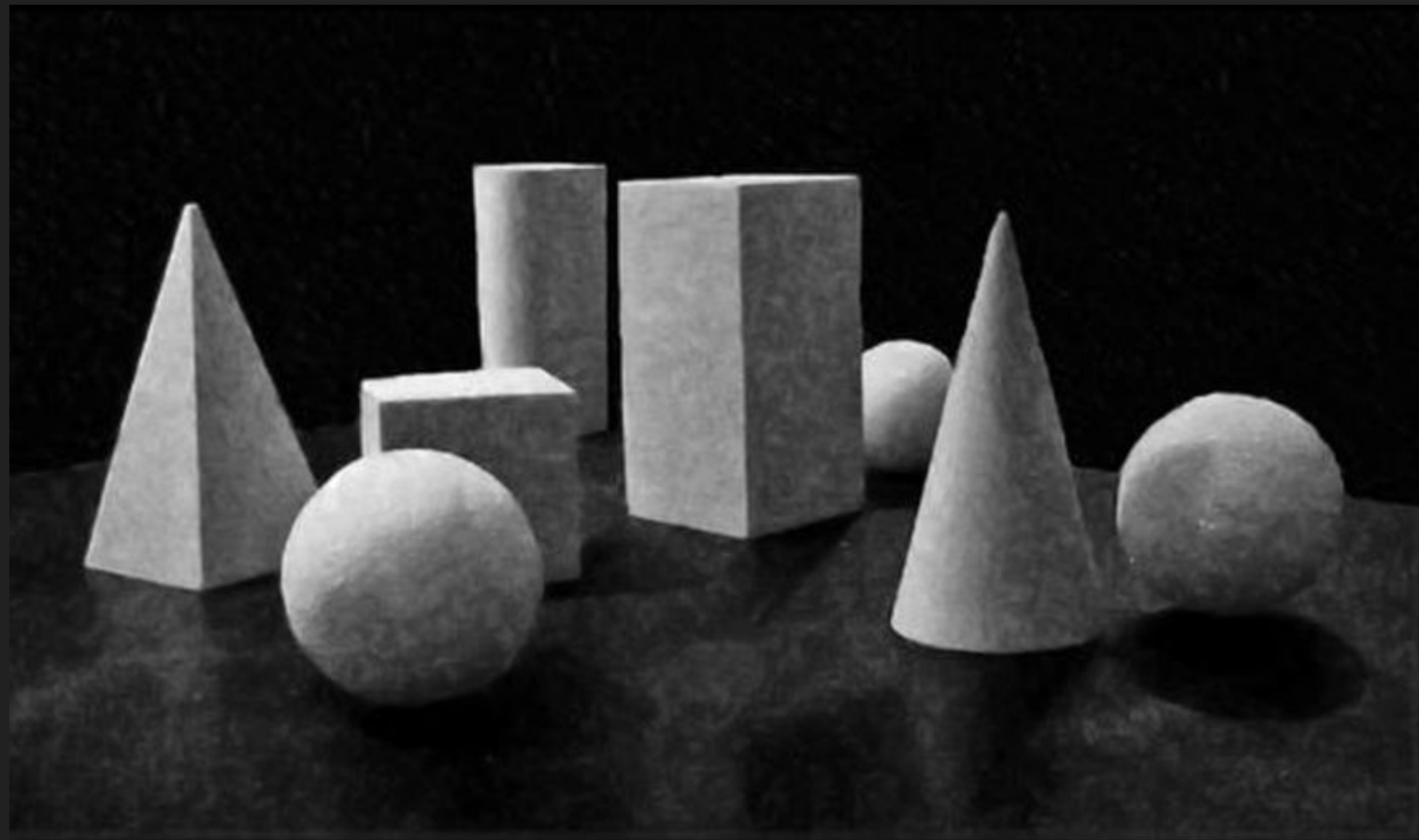

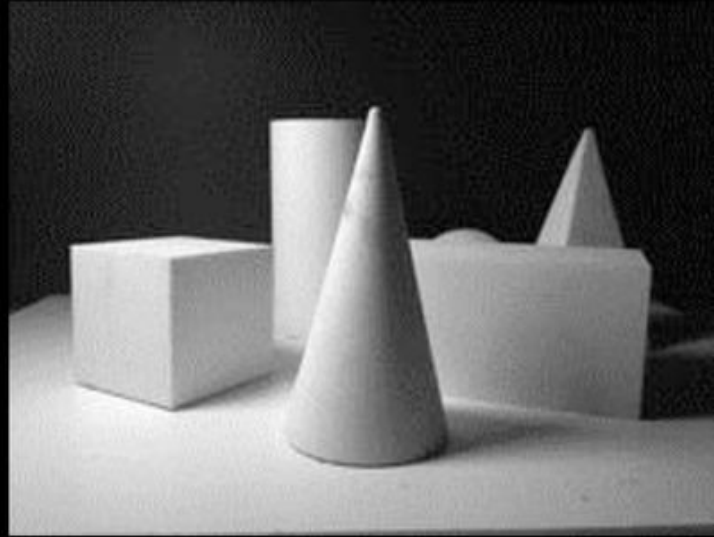




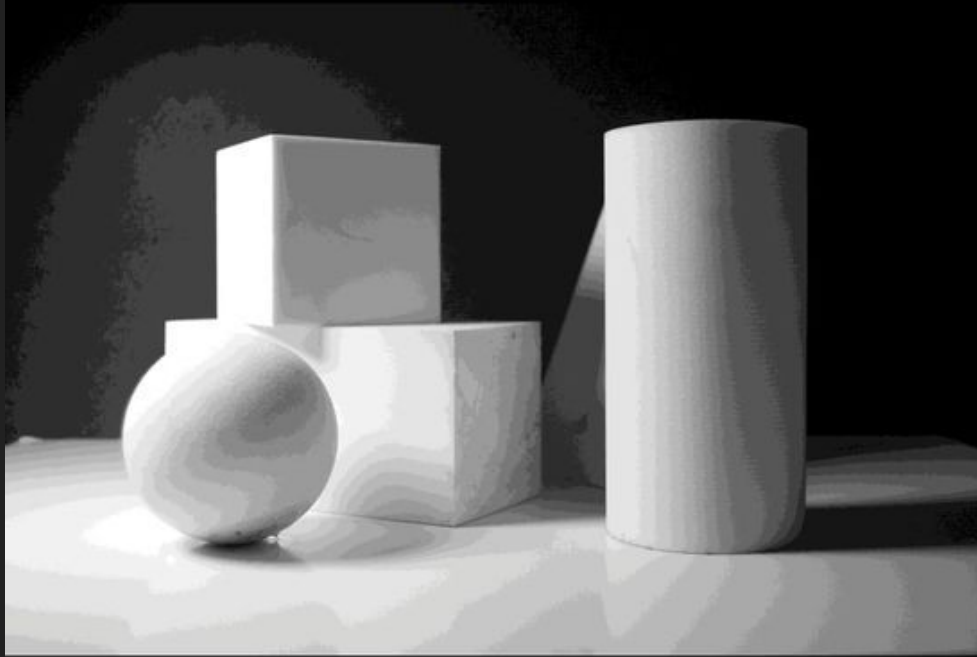
What will you do?

Fill the space well.

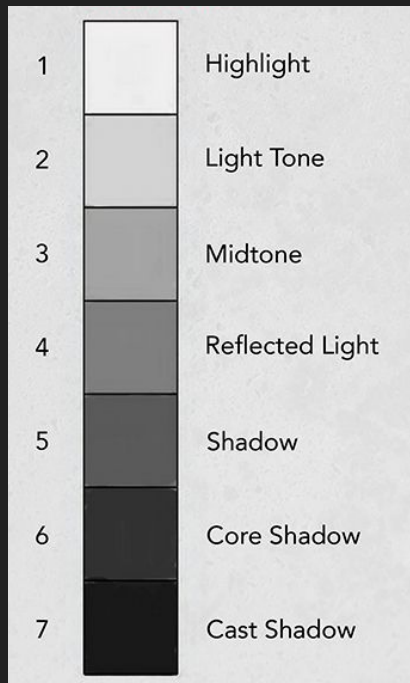
AND...don't draw small in

Still-Life Img

1. Use 5 Geometric Forms
2. Arrange them to show Hierarchy (Tallest), Overlapping, Proportion, Placement, and Diagonals.
3. Take a picture and crop it so we only see the box and the contents.
4. Upload the image to Artsonia
5. Create a Value Finder using the index card and hole puncher.
6. Work on Bellwork

Value Finder

5. Cree un Buscador de valor utilizando la tarjeta de índice y el perforador.

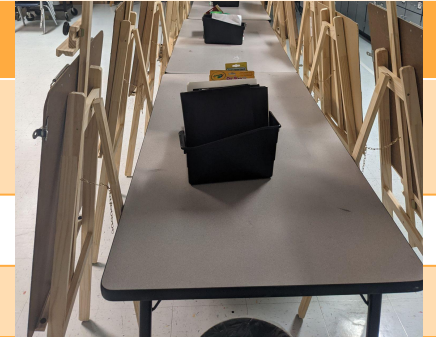
